someone else has.



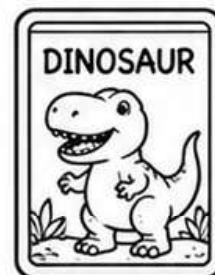
Trading is when two people

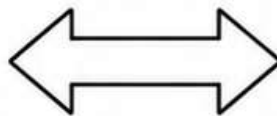

How Do We Make a Good Trade?



Good traders follow these steps!

A good trade is fair for **BOTH** people.
It helps everyone feel happy.
Let's learn how to make a good trade!



Good trades are fair, kind and helpful.
They help build trust and friendship!



Follow these steps and everyone can win!



Read each step. Then draw a picture that shows what you can do.

1 Think about what YOU want.

What do you need or want?
What is important to you?

2 Think about what THEY want.

What does the other person need or want?
Listen and ask questions!

3 Make an offer.

Choose something you have that the other person might like.
Offer it and see what they think!

4 Check if it's fair for BOTH.

Will **BOTH** of you feel happy with the trade?
If not, try again!

5 Agree and say THANK YOU!

If you both agree, make the trade and say thank you!
Celebrate a good trade!

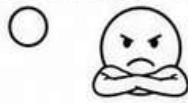
